June 4th 2019 public speakout comments

Considering Puna pays the same amount of taxes as the rest of the island and has the largest population of any district on the big island,
And we will never have county water / fire hydrants nor county sewer.
so maybe the county can help with flooding problems in Hawaiian acres / orchidland and ainaloa at G. road.
more emergency access routes for emergency personnel and transportation throughout puna and possibly find a way to put in intersection Street lights in the more densely populated (say 51% or better) Puna subdivisions.

A (text version) of the civil defense siren tests at the beginning of every month.

All potable water on this island should use solar power to pump the water out of the ground and possibly recover some of that electricity as the water runs downhill as much as 1000 ft in elevation. At the two perfect times of the day when people are getting out of bed in the morning and when people come home in the evening is when most of the water is being used and when most of the electricity is being used.
Promote gravity electric storage, the pendulum method at more than 90% efficiency.
Pumped hydro in this case salt water and possibly compressed air underneath the oceans surface.

Find solar power companies willing to buy back all of the land that makes up the lower Puna subdivisions that have been covered by lava particularly the puu oo
Vent. The idea of being about the time the solar panels have reached the end of their useful life, is about the same time the lava might start flowing again 25 to 50 years and Then after making a profit for years, donate the land to the national Park.

Open route 148 to sadel rd.

Open Komohana St. extension to keeau bypass intersection.

Open railroad avenue from Hilo to Puna.

Improve stainback highway from Hilo side to at least North kuhlani.

Widened South kuhlani bridge.

Improve the old volcano trail from South kuhlani to Ala Naulani Rd. In Fern Forest.

County maintained fire department water tanks with stand pipes in Puna subdivisions as far away from county fire hydrants as possible.
