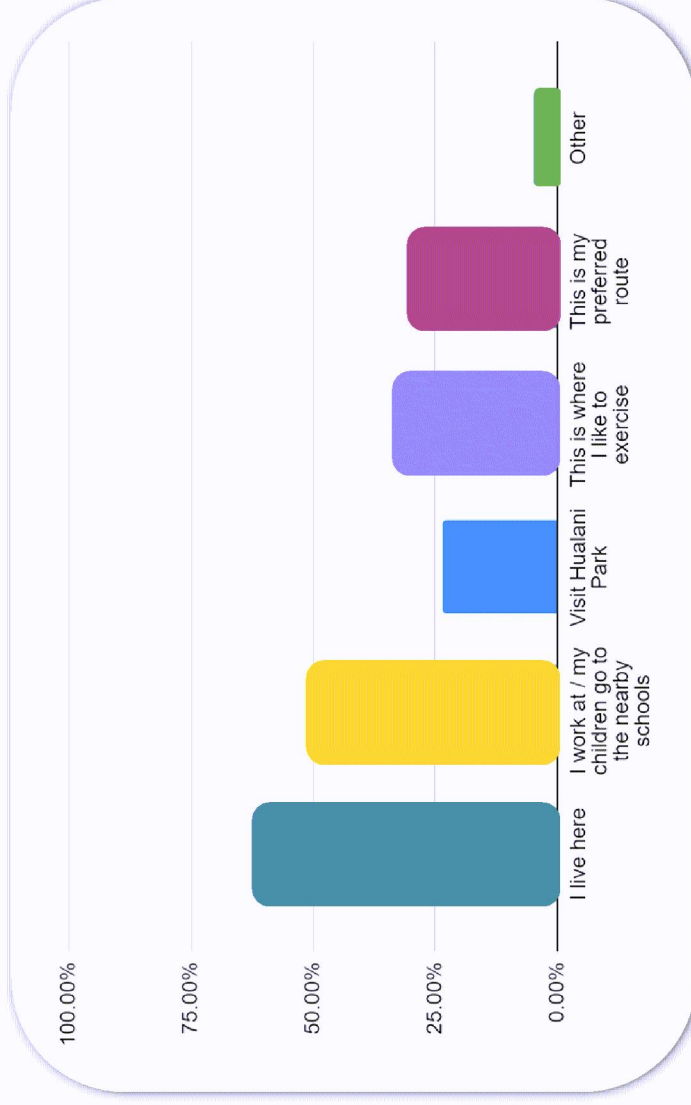

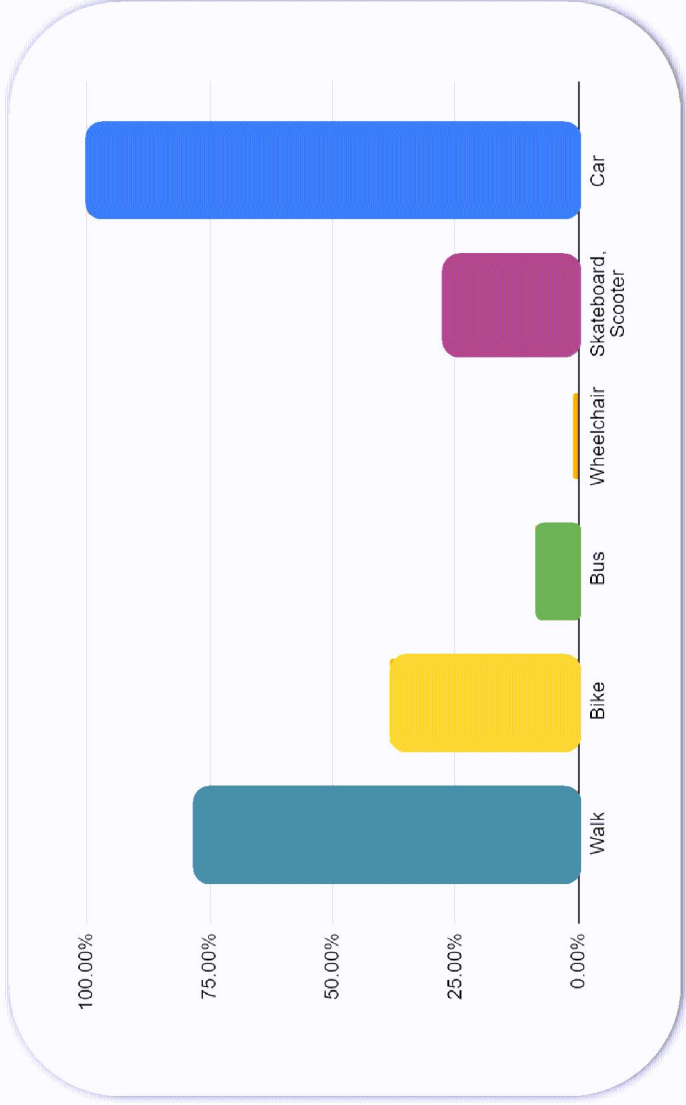
Reason for Travel

“Bigger walking area”

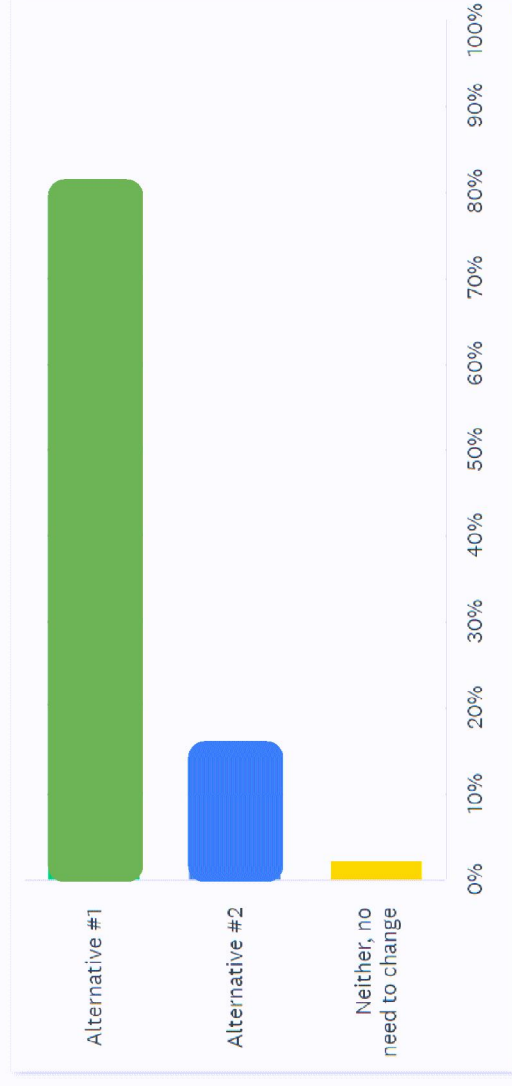

artwork around the whole perimeter”

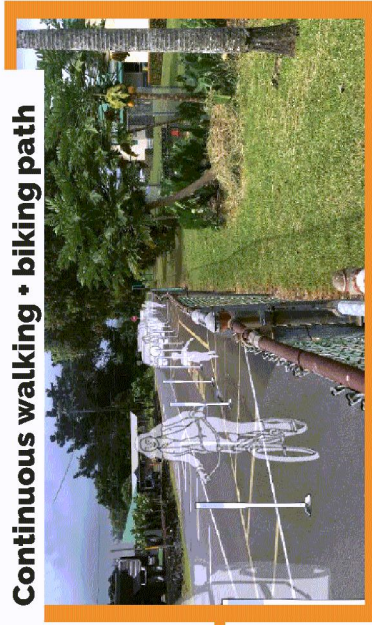
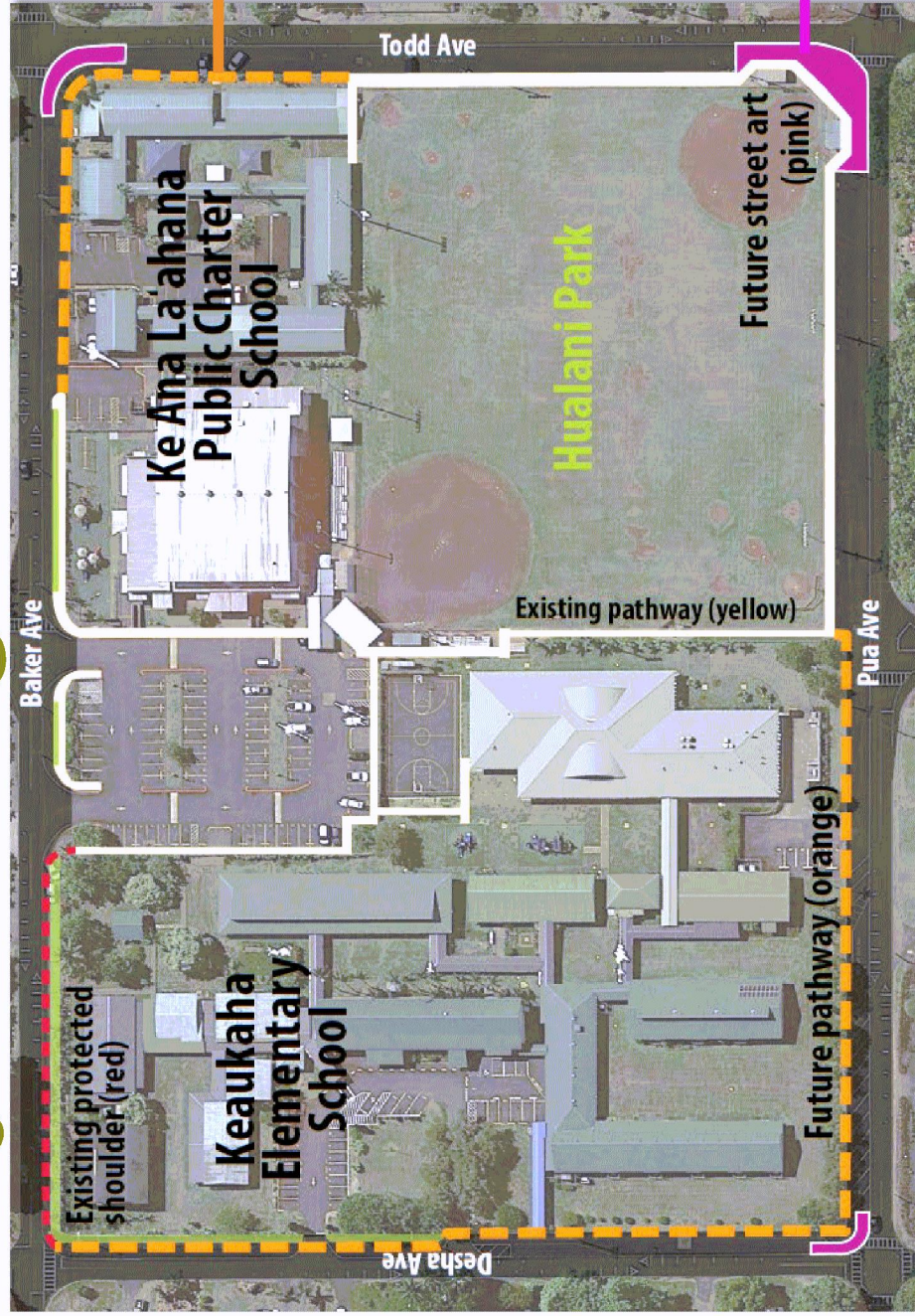
Respondents support Alternative #1 (continuous walking/biking path)

14% prefer Alternative 2**

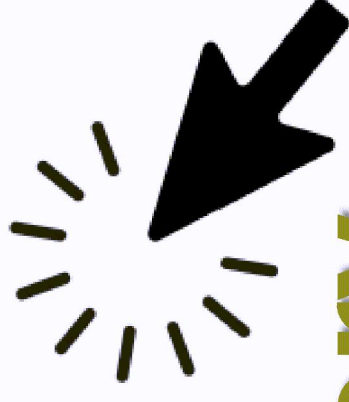
