

BOARD OF ETHICS FACT SHEET

Purpose:	To interpret the County’s Code of Ethics for officers, employees, and the public; receive and initiate complaints; conduct hearings on violations and render opinions.	
Authority:	Hawai’i County Charter, Section 14-5	
Appointment:	Mayor with Council approval. Normal five-year staggered terms.	
Full Membership:	Seven members (4 quorum).	
Specific Representation:	None required.	
Requirements:	Members must be residents of the County.	
Meetings:	Once a month, on the 2 nd Wednesday of each month.	
Financial Disclosure:	Members must file confidential financial disclosures within 20 working days of taking the oath of office. Thereafter, annual disclosures must be filed on or before January 31 st . The disclosures are confidential and will be kept on file by the Board of Ethics. County Code, Chapter 2, Section 2-91.1.	
Reappointment:	Following the expiration of a term, no member may be reappointed for at least two years.	
Qualities:	Respected by the community as being community-minded and oriented. Able to focus on the community needs as a whole without catering to special or self-interest.
