

RESOLUTION NO. 369 23**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE OFFICE OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT TO AWARD FUNDS TO VARIOUS NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS FOR PROGRAMS ADDRESSING HOUSING AND HOMELESSNESS**

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 2, Article 25, Section 2-139(a)(3)(A) of the Hawai'i County Code (2016 Edition as amended) states, Grant awards in excess of \$25,000 to nonprofit organizations shall specifically identify the organization receiving the grant funds and the purpose for which the grant funds shall be used in an ordinance or resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 2, Article 25, Section 2-136(5) of the Hawai'i County Code states, "nonprofit organization" means an organization organized for other than profit-making purposes and which has a current 501(c)3 tax-exemption from the Internal Revenue Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the organizations specified in "Exhibit A", which correspondingly qualify as a nonprofit organizations as defined above, will provide initiatives and programs addressing housing and homelessness; and

**WHEREAS**, the Office of Housing and Community Development (OHCD) wishes to provide a total of \$9,794,459.33 to these organizations as outlined in "Exhibit A"; now, therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE COUNTY OF HAWAI'I**, in accordance with Chapter 2, Article 25, Section 2-139(a)(3)(A) of the Hawai'i County Code, the OHCD is authorized to provide grants totaling of \$9,794,459.33 to various

nonprofit organizations as specified in "Exhibit A" to provide initiatives and programs addressing housing and homelessness.

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the County Clerk of the County of Hawai'i shall transmit copies of this resolution to the Office of the Mayor, the Finance Department, and the Office of Housing and Community Development.
