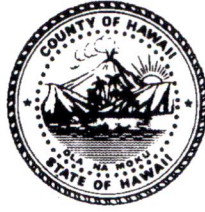

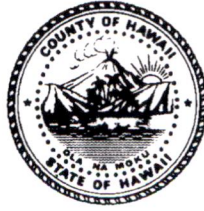

² "DHHL Credits" may be earned for the production of housing developed for the State of Hawai'i Department of Hawaiian Homelands ("DHHL") beneficiaries or for DHHL purposes. In accordance with the DHHL Affordable Housing Credit Policy (as amended), DHHL Credits are transferrable for the use of satisfying an affordable housing requirement of an eligible development project within the same DHHL region (or County) in which they were earned. The DHHL credits listed in this exhibit were earned within the Hawaii Island DHHL region.
