Duties and Responsibilities of the Special Inspector and Registered Design Professional in Responsible Charge:

1. Observe work assigned for conformance with applicable codes, approved design drawings, and specifications.
2. Furnish inspection reports to the owner, the engineer or architect of record and other owner-designated persons. All discrepancies shall be brought to the immediate attention of the contractor for correction; then, if uncorrected, to the proper design authority and to the building official.
3. Prior to the final inspection, the registered design professional in responsible charge shall submit a written statement verifying receipt of the final special inspection reports and documenting that there are no known unresolved code requirements that create significant public safety deficiencies.
