ORDINANCE NO. 89 102

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 14, ARTICLE 10, OF THE HAWAII COUNTY CODE, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO EXCEPTIONAL TREES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 14, Article 10, of the Hawaii County Code, 1983, is amended by adding six trees to the existing list of eleven exceptional trees, as follows:

"SECTION 14-65. Designated Exceptional Trees.

The following trees are designated as 'Exceptional Trees of the County of Hawaii':
