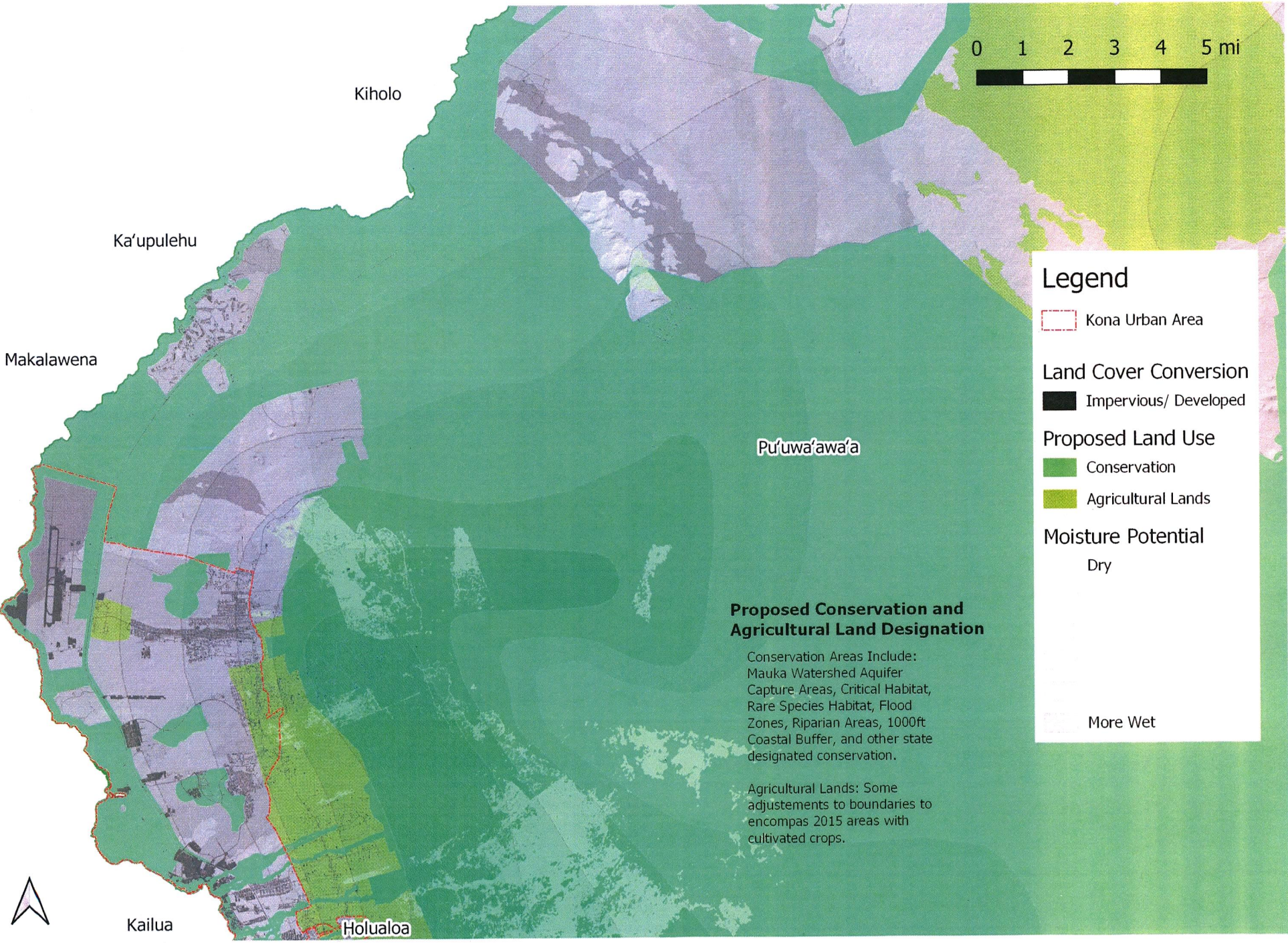

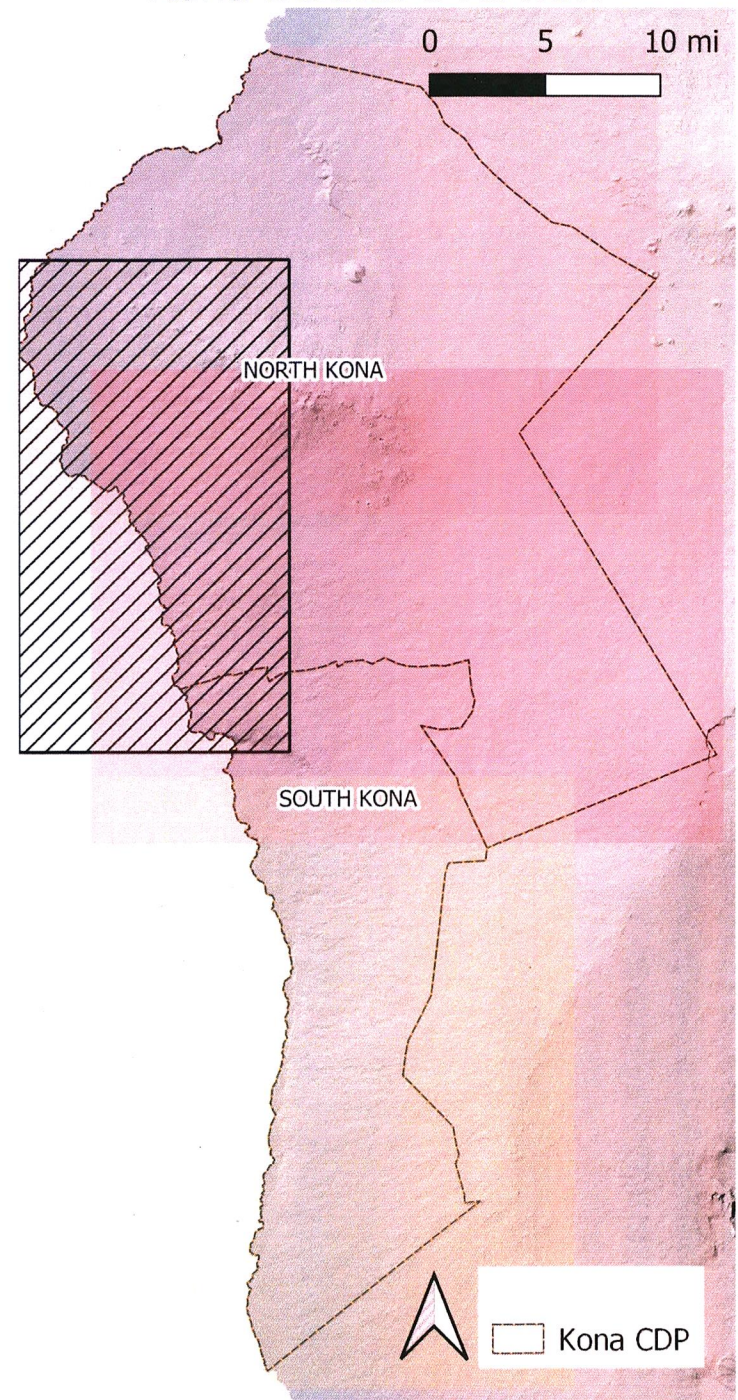

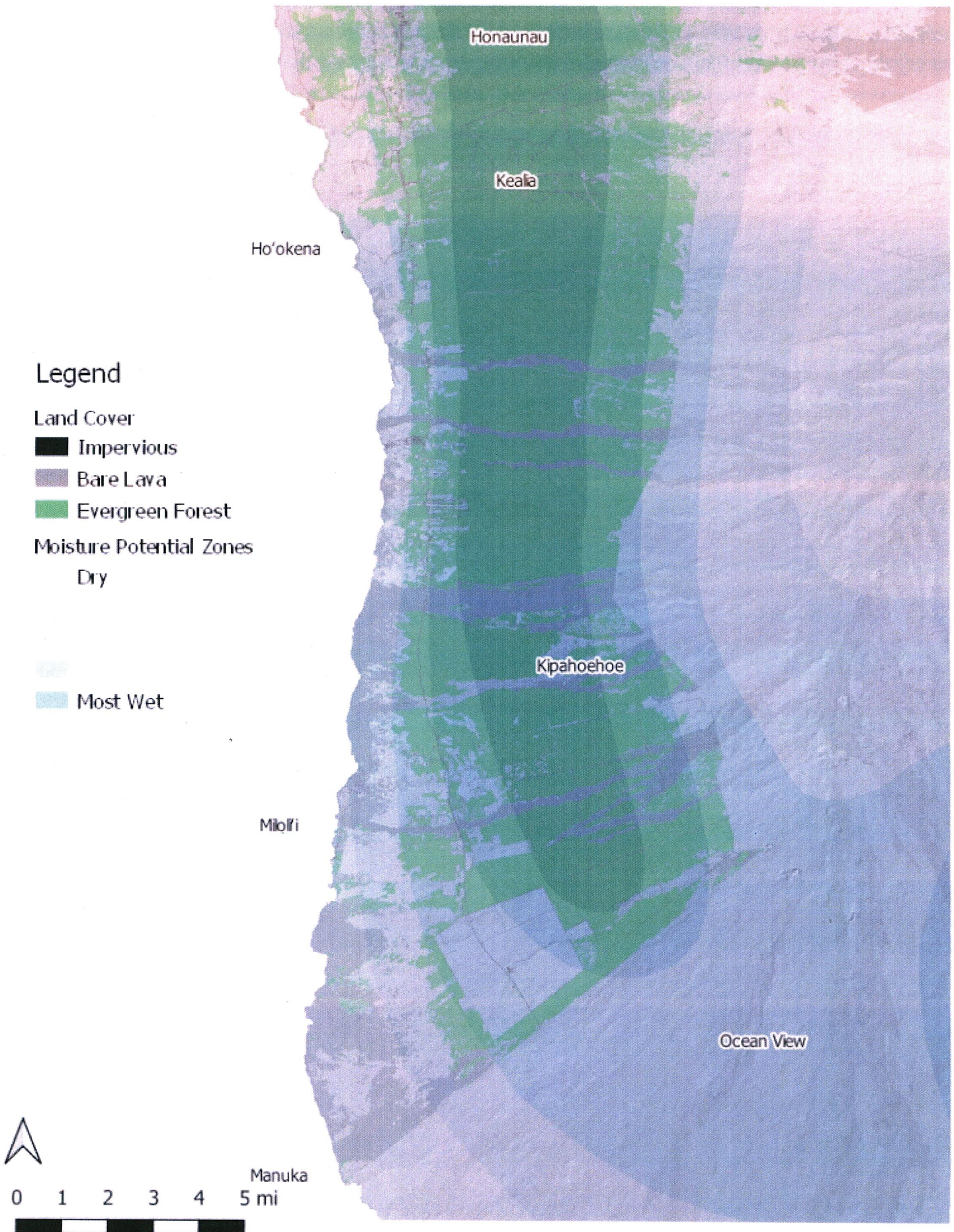

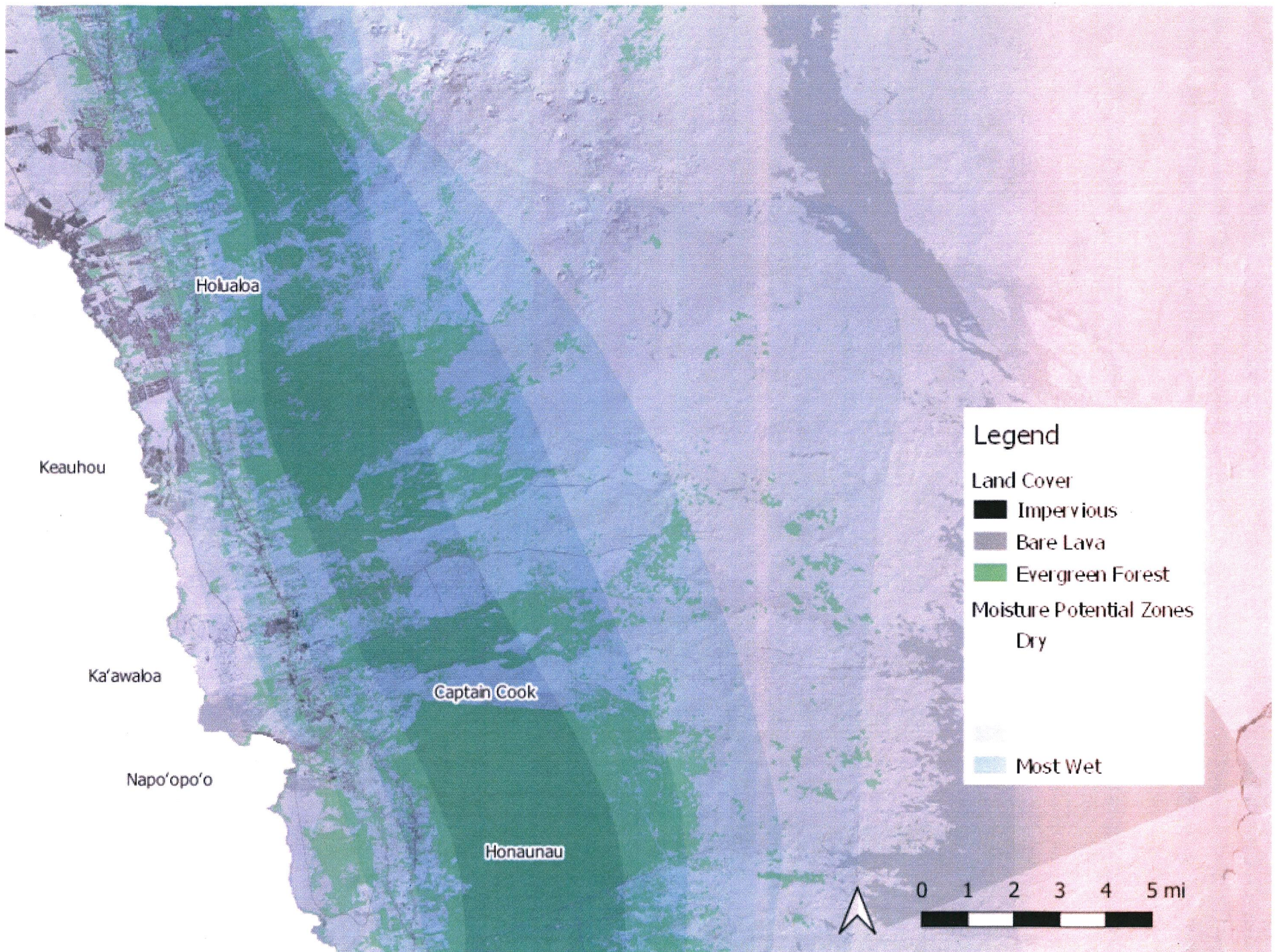

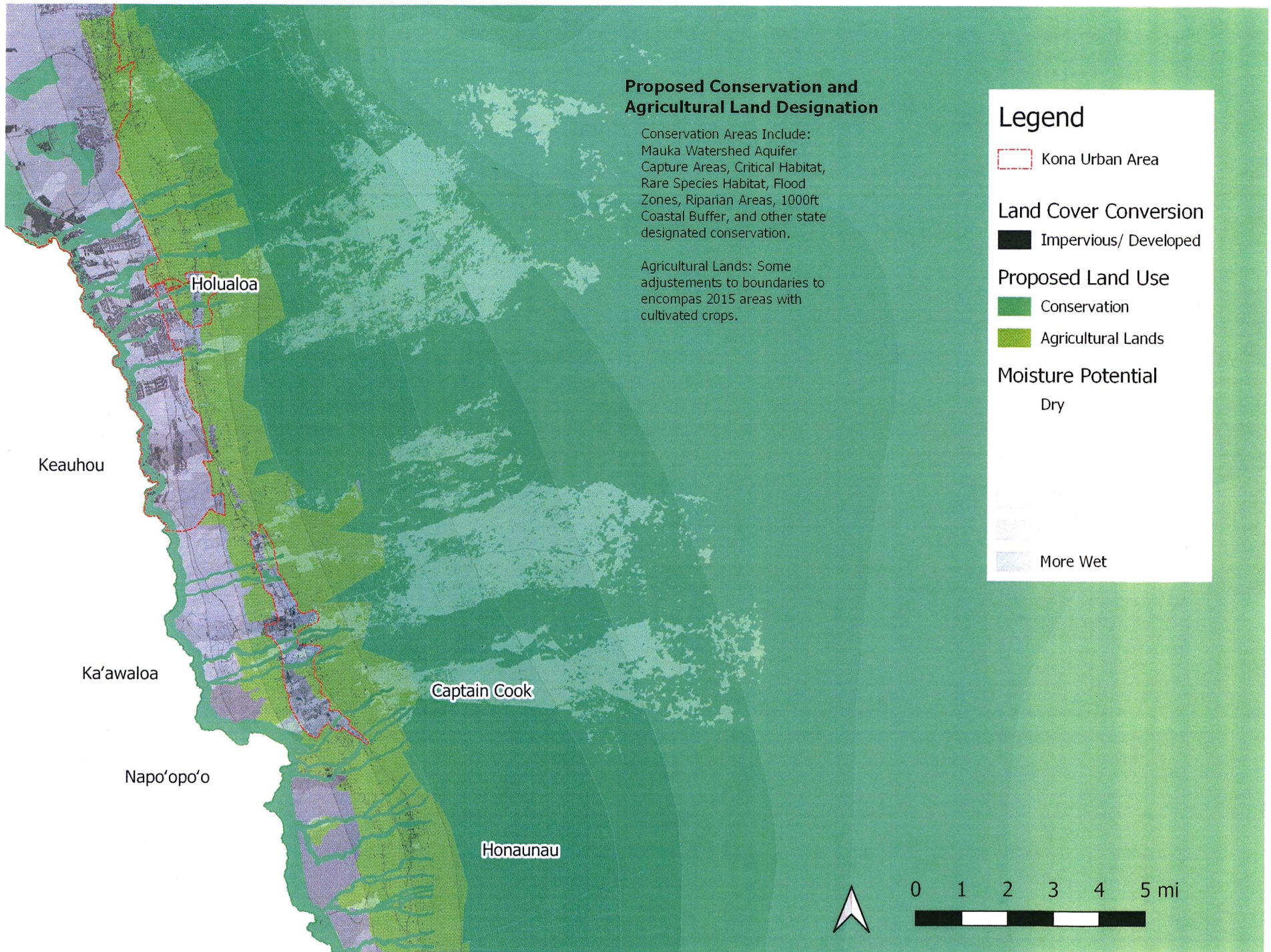

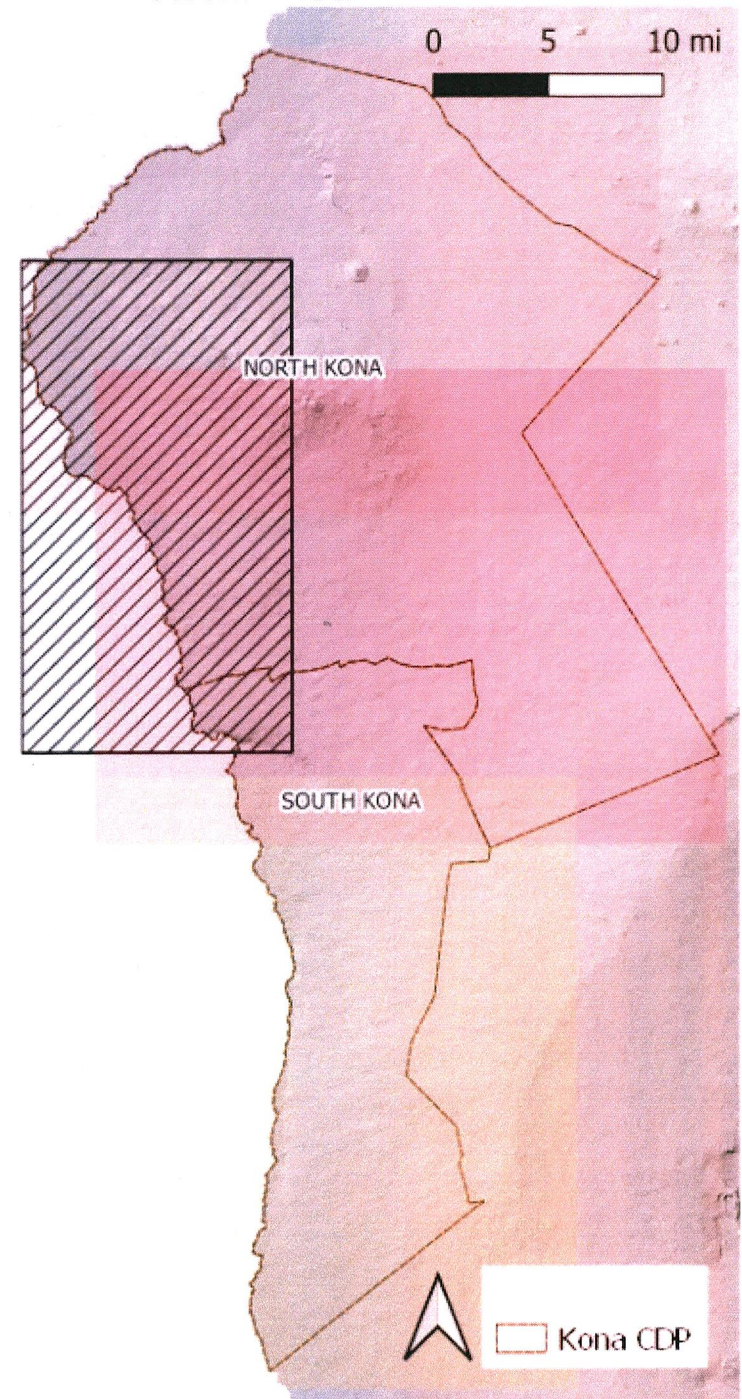
Kona Districts Map 2
