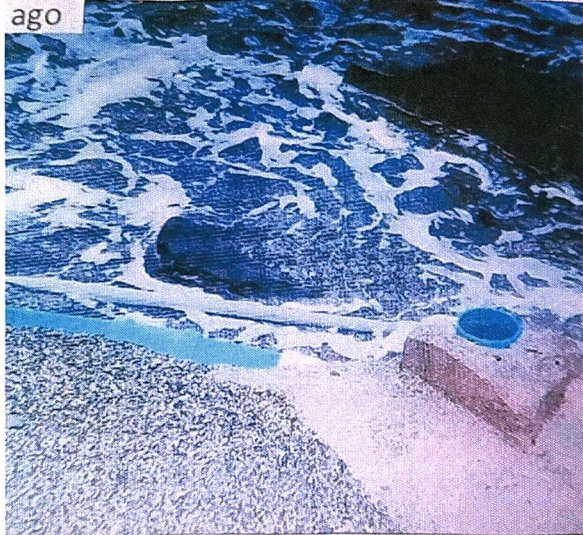
I took these photos at Kahaluu Beach Park. The sea has already risen. This was 80 feet back, 20 years ago in the photo.

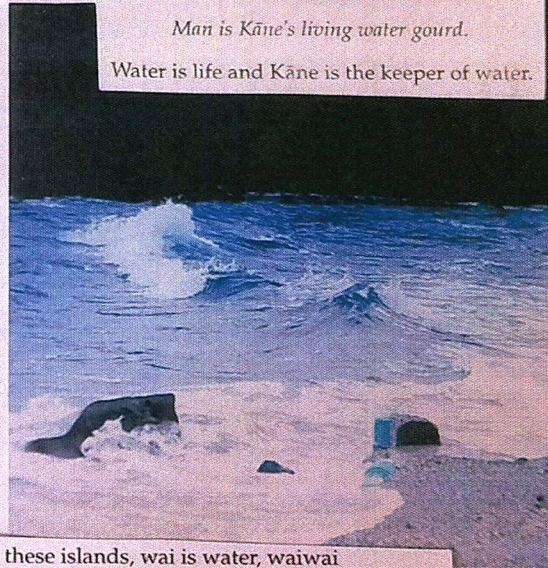
Cesspool is in the shoreline, was 80 feet back 20
