Homeowner Assistance Program

- Overview
 - HAF will provide Hawai'i homeowners who are experiencing financial hardship after January 21, 2020, associated with the COVID-19 pandemic and have incomes at or below 150% of the area median income with assistance that will lead to long-term mortgage resolution.
 - Grants up to \$30,000 to assist homeowners who are in financial hardship pay past due mortgages or reduce monthly payments.

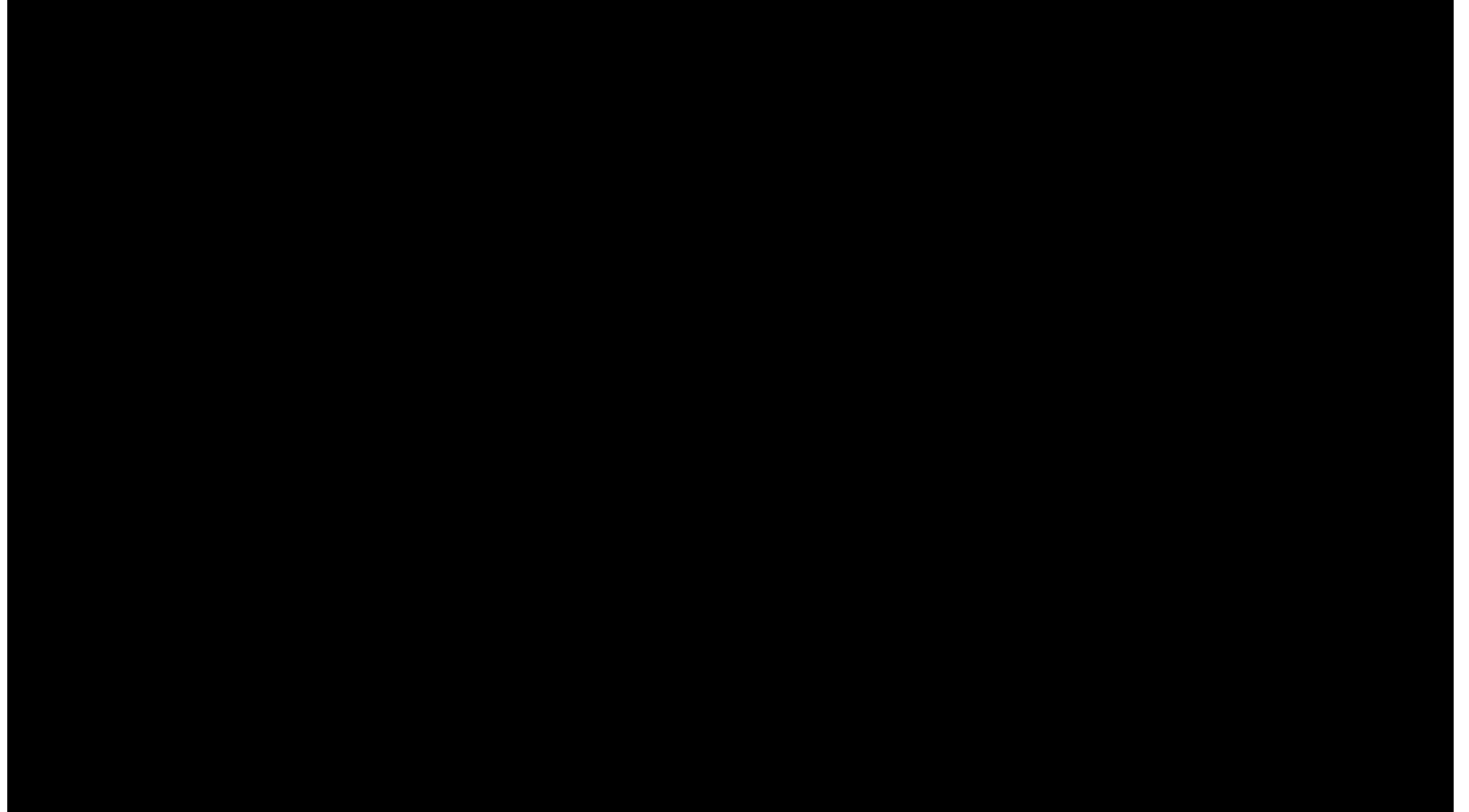

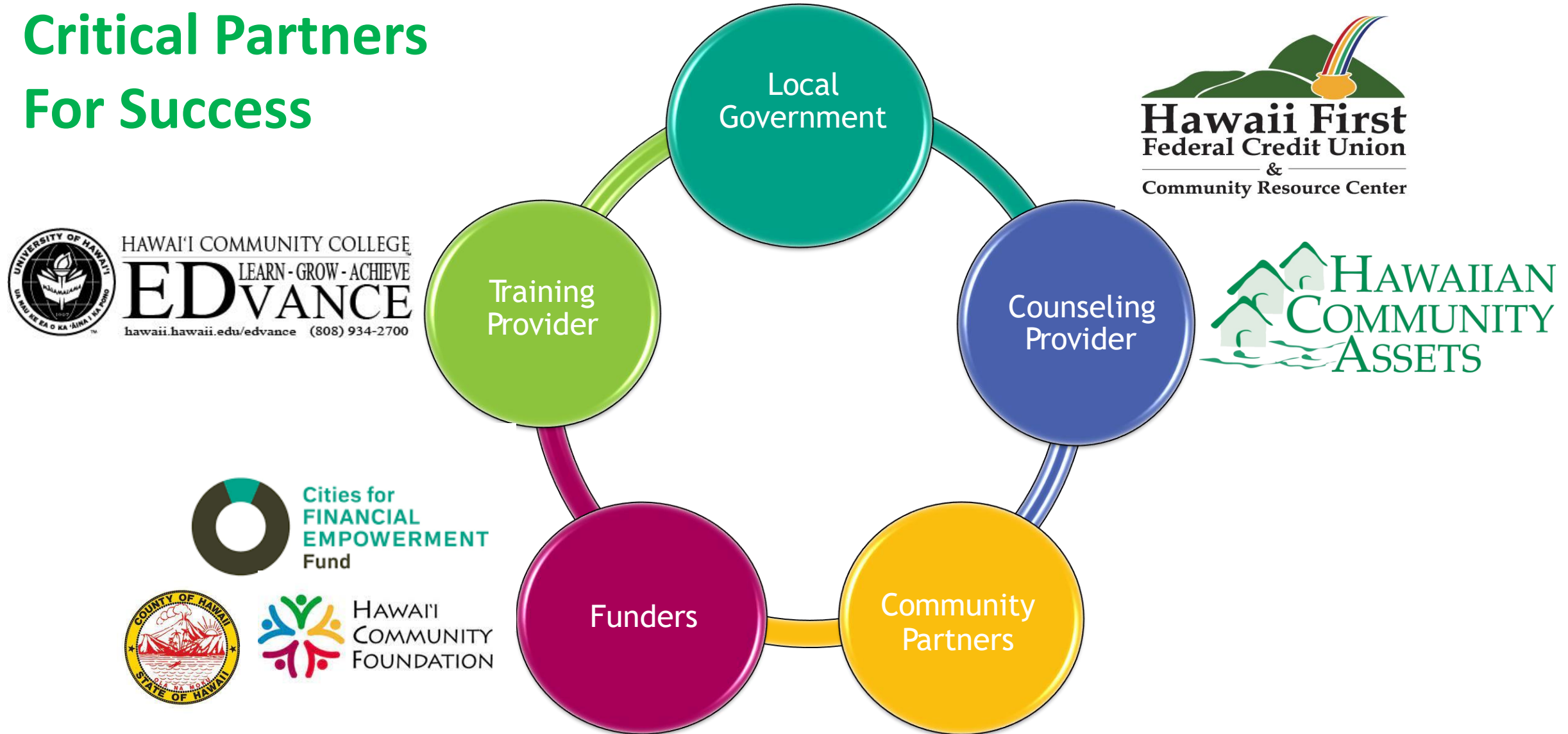

The Financial Empowerment Center initiative provides free, one- on-one financial counseling as a public service to all residents.

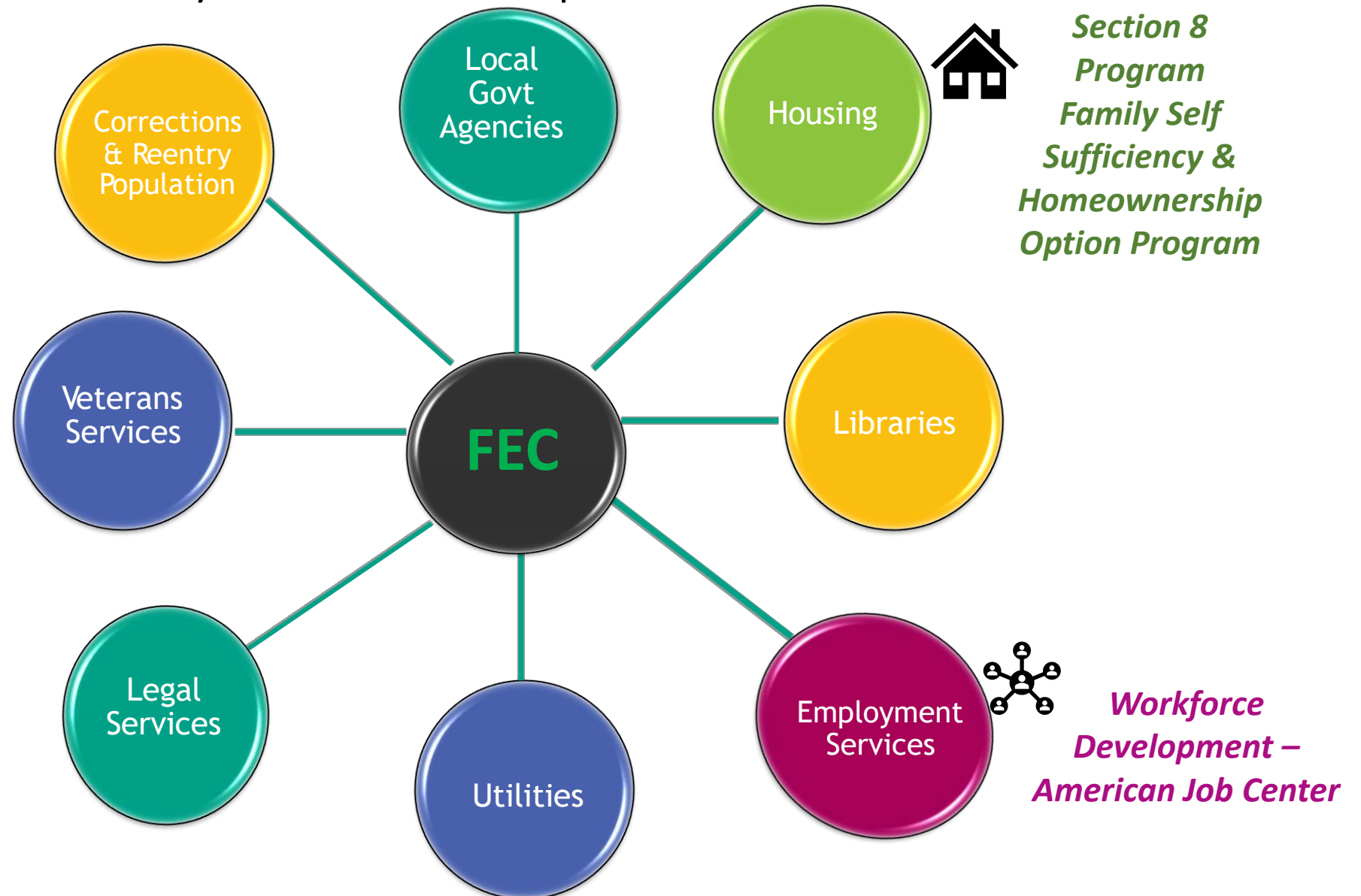
